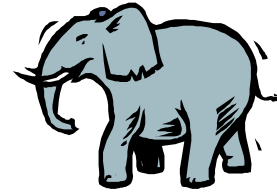

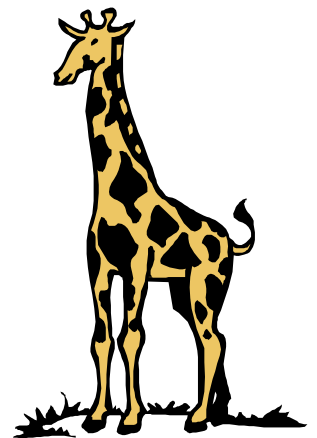

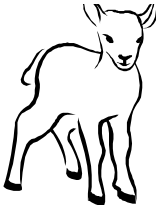
1:00p.m. - Tres Dias Workshop - Part II
