# President's Letter

Our Lord and Savior, Jesus, said in Luke 11: 24-26 "When an evil spirit comes out of a man, it goes through arid places seeking rest and does not find it. Then it says, 'I will return to the house I left.' When it arrives, it finds the house swept clean and put in order. Then it goes and takes seven other spirits more wicked than itself, and they go in and live there. And the final condition of that man is worse than the first."

This comment of Jesus is also referenced in Matthew 12. It seems to be a haunting warning to the disciples...and to us involved in a ministry such as Tres Dias. There's no question about it – Spiritual warfare is VERY real, the stakes are HIGH, and we are now in the game whether we want to be or not. This seems clear: When we follow the Tres Dias method of Piety, Study, and Action, strengthening the local church, supporting each other in prayer, and spreading the blessing of the Gospel, as we grow in effectiveness and commitment to the Great Commandment and the Great Commission, one of the consequences is that we also rise on Satan's "Most Wanted List".

Thus, our commitment as sponsors: Our role as sponsor **continues** until the new Pescadore "is successfully installed in their Fourth Day." It is absolutely crucial for the spiritual health of our candidates that we as sponsors commit to teach the value of Reunion Groups, Secuelas, and effective sponsorship of others. *Otherwise, when we sponsor someone, we are actually putting that person at risk for the final sentence in verse 26 above.* Please make the effort to convey to those you have sponsored, and those you feel led to sponsor, the CRITICAL importance of gathering together with a few likeminded people on a regular basis for accountability, nourishment, and prayer support. Use this scripture to drive the point home to them. Tres Dias is NOT just about the Weekend – it's an ongoing method for strengthening the local church. The Weekend is Phase Two. Pam Belknap brought this related insight back from Tres Dias International: In South Korea, where there are now over 200 Tres Dias Communities, medallions are presented to the Candidates during the Apostolic Hour. On one side is a cross and on the other are 5 horses. A "5-horse" message means "a matter of life and death--proceed at ALL personal cost."

## A word on Weekend Fees:

72 hours at a retreat center includes 3 nights lodging, 8 meals, facilities, and lots of supplies paid for by Tres Dias. The actual cost of a Weekend is in the neighborhood of \$250-\$300; so the \$200 Weekend fee is a reasonable expense. Here are some thoughts about handling this expense in the context of inviting a candidate to attend.

Of course, with the majority of candidates we sponsor, \$200 for a time focused on the LORD is not an issue, especially if one pays half at the time of application and the rest shortly before the Weekend. And it's a good way to lock the candidate in and protect them from succumbing to the inevitable spiritual attack to keep them away. But some candidates the LORD moves us to invite may find it difficult to pay the cost. And the enemy will often whisper in their ear about the money in an effort to keep them off the Weekend (and thereby potentially limit their effectiveness in strengthening the local church). So how about suggesting a sharing of the costs? Or, if you both are struggling financially at the time, suggest a potential scholarship and then speak to your original sponsor or someone else in leadership. Sponsors are not expected to pay the fee, but if you feel the pull to pay for your candidate, go ahead. You can even say "I know someone who is willing to pay the cost for you to attend. Don't worry about it. Consider it a gift from the Lord." And then pay it yourself, perhaps anonymously to the candidate. By the way, make sure to use the current form and send it to Denise Palma, our new point of contact.
