Pay It Forward

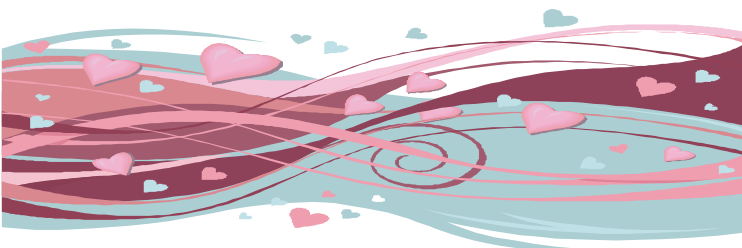


Pay It Forward is the only way we can continue to keep the registration fee for candidates to \$50.00.
